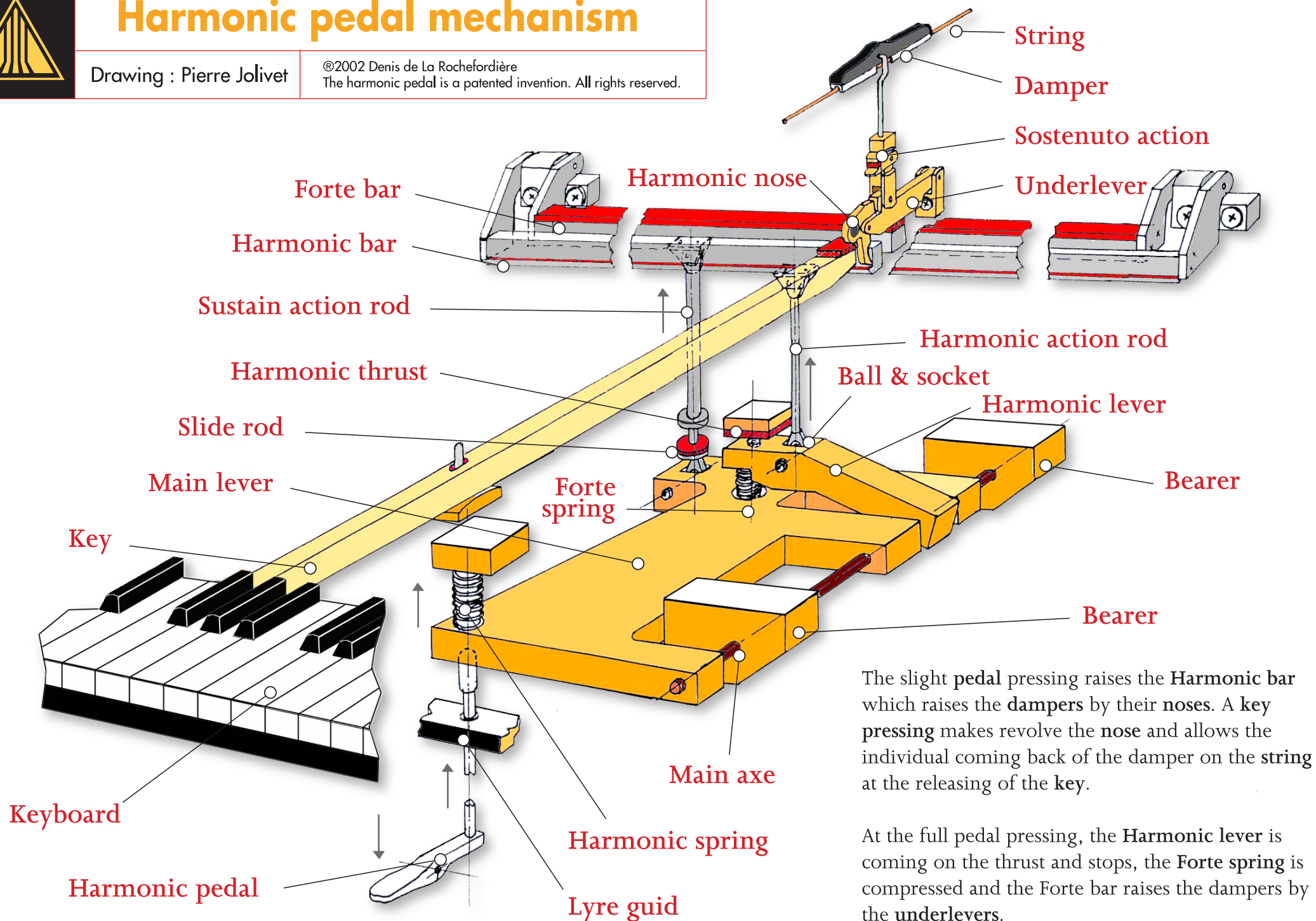




# Harmonic pedal mechanism

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The slight pedal pressing raises the Harmonic bar which raises the dampers by their noses. A key pressing makes revolve the nose and allows the individual coming back of the damper on the string at the releasing of the key.

At the full pedal pressing, the Harmonic lever is coming on the thrust and stops, the Forte spring is compressed and the Forte bar raises the dampers by the underlevers.
